*“And the **Good News about the Kingdom** will be preached throughout the whole world, so that all nations will hear it; and then the end will come.”* Matthew 24:14 NLT

What is the Good News of the Kingdom?

First and foremost the great news is:

Jesus is the *King of Kings and Lord of lords*. Revelation 19:16

Jesus, the Son of God came to earth from heaven and said:

“The time promised by God has come at last!” he announced. *“The **Kingdom of God is near! Repent of your sins and believe the Good News!**”* Mark 1:15 NLT

Jesus brought His kingdom, which is not of this world, to earth. John 18:36

Jesus taught His disciples, which includes those alive today, to pray,

*“**Your kingdom come Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.**”*
Matthew 6:10 NKJV

This is our prayer of agreement with the divine plans and purposes of God.

What is the grand plan of God for heaven and earth?

The plan of God is to bring heaven and earth together under the authority of Christ Jesus.

*“God has now revealed to us his mysterious plan regarding Christ, a plan to fulfill his own good pleasure. ¹⁰ And **this is the plan: At the right time He will bring everything together under the authority of Christ—everything in heaven and on earth.**”* Ephesians 1:9-10 NLT

It is said that God answers our desperate prayers. Our prayers for the will of God to be done on earth will become increasingly more desperate as the will of man increases and darkness covers the earth.

*“For behold, the **darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people;**”*
Isaiah 60:2a NLT

Jesus invites His followers, His disciples, His saints to walk in His glorious light.

*“But the LORD will arise over you, And **His glory will be seen upon you.**”*
Isaiah 60:2 b NKJV

*“**You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.**”*
Matthew 5:14 NKJV

*“**Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.**”* Matthew 5:16 NKJV

How do you enter into the Kingdom of God?

We must believe in Jesus and be born again by the Spirit.

The Good News of the Kingdom

“... *“Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household.”* Acts 16:31 NLT

“Jesus replied, “I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit.” John 3:5 NLT

You must obey the Lord and follow His will with child-like faith.

*“When you **obey my commandments**, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father’s commandments and remain in his love.”* John 15:10 NLT

“... *“Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and **become as little children**, you will by no means **enter the kingdom of heaven**.”*

Matthew 18:3 NKJV

We enter into the kingdom through the ‘door’ Jesus Christ who is our only way to the Father.

*“Jesus told him, **“I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.”*** John 14:6 NLT

Followers of Jesus hear His voice and follow Him.

*“**My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.**”*

John 10:27 NLT

How do you live in proper relationship with God and in His Kingdom of God?

Jesus said that the first, most important greatest commandment is that you whole heartedly love God.

*“... **you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.**”* Mark 12:30 -31 NLT

This is one reason why God sent His Son to earth, to demonstrate His great sacrificial love for us.

*“**For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.**”*

John 3:16 NLT

Mary of Bethany demonstrated her devotion the Lord by sitting at His feet to hear His teaching, and her extravagant love for Him by anointing Him with very costly perfume. Jesus recognized her loving sacrifice by saying:

Assuredly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done will also be told as a memorial to her.”

Mark 14:9 NKJV

How do you live in a loving relationship with others and in the Kingdom of God?

And Jesus also said the second most important thing is to love others.

*“**The second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ No other commandment is greater than these.**”* Mark 12:31 NLT

The Good News of the Kingdom

Those who believe and obey are called *children of God*, Romans 18:14; *God is love*.
1 John 4:8

Jesus commanded us to love one another.

“This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.”
John 15:12 NKJV

The apostle Peter also wrote, *“And above all things have fervent love for one another, for
“love will cover a multitude of sins.” And love covers a multitude of sins.”* 1
Peter 4:8 NKJV

What has Jesus already done for us?

Jesus paid the very high price for our sin, and our rebellion to the ways and will of God. He paid with His life, His blood as the perfect atoning sacrifice paying for our salvation, redemption and restoration into a righteous relationship with God forever.

What will it cost us to follow Jesus into His kingdom?

Something of such great value comes at a great price.

It will cost us everything, our whole life. We are to always follow the example of Jesus and give our lives to God. We are called to willingly *surrender* our lives to Jesus Christ, as our act of worship, to love Him and serve Him. Then He will live His life *through* us in the Spirit.

“Then Jesus said to his disciples, “If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross, and follow me.”
Matthew 16:24; Mark 8:34 Luke 3:23 NLT

Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.” Romans 12:1 NASB

“For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead.” Colossians 2:12 NLT

How does the Kingdom of God grow?

Jesus commissioned His disciples, which includes His followers alive today to,

“...go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. 20 Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:19-20 NLT

When and where will the Kingdom of God come to earth?

The Kingdom of God is at hand on earth, in a partial way now.

The Good News of the Kingdom

Jesus brought the Kingdom of God with Him to earth.

The Kingdom of God is revealed on earth now through the lives of those who truly believe in Jesus, and who follow, honor and obey Him as their Savior, Lord and King. Jesus' disciples, His set apart, consecrated, sanctified saints, are being *transformed* into the image of Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit working *in* us and *through* us. We are called to be the hands, feet, and voice of Jesus wherever we are now, and to manifest His kingdom.

The truth of the message of the Kingdom of God will be confirmed with *supernatural* signs and wonders. These signs include salvations, healing and deliverance from oppression all in the power and presence of the Holy Spirit working through His yielded, pure, obedient saints, like present day John the Baptist, who is our model of a forerunner, we are to preach the truth and power of repentance and “*prepare the way of the Lord.*” Matthew 3:3 NKJV

Every salvation, healing, deliverance and disciple is a partial manifestation of the kingdom of heaven coming in fullness to earth.

What is the Kingdom of God like?

It is described in the Bible as glorious place.

The fullness of the Kingdom of God is a glorious paradise beyond our greatest imaginations. It is a beautiful place of peace and safety without tears, pain, sickness or death where we will live in the glorious presence of the Lord, and serving in a loving partnership with Him forever!

“... *“No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him.”* 1 Corinthians 2:9 NLT

Jesus taught about 30 parables saying the “Kingdom of God is like...”

Jesus taught 12 things that the kingdom of God is, and 18 times about inheriting the kingdom of God

The kingdom of God is our destiny. Contend for inheriting the kingdom of God.

The King is the most influence person. Without a king there is no kingdom.

1. First the **kingdom of God** is the **rule** and **reign of God**. The King of kings has dominion.

*The LORD said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.” The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. **Rule** in the midst of Your enemies! Your people shall be volunteers In the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth. Psalm 110:1-3 NKJV*

The Good News of the Kingdom

The King is of the order of Melchizedek. The marriage supper of the Lamb is coming soon

2. The kingdom of God is an **everlasting** kingdom. The King is faithful to all His promises. His covenants are everlasting. The covenants are to restore the kingdom of God. The fall of the kingdom came in the Garden of Eden. God walked with Adam in the Garden. The covenants with Abraham and David are all to restore the kingdom. Jesus was the birth of the King.

Why was Jesus born? To die for our sins. Yes. Jesus is called the King 50 times in the Gospels and 20 times He is called Savior.

*Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that **I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice.**" John 18:37 NKJV*

The kingdom of God is being restored to Israel.

3. The kingdom of God is **unshakable**. You are unshakeable if you are in the kingdom of God.

*Therefore, since we are receiving a **kingdom which cannot be shaken**, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. Hebrews 12:28 NKJV*

4. The kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but **righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit**. Romans 14:17

5. The kingdom of God is **spiritual**. It is invisible.

*Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood** cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. 1 Corinthians 15:50 NKJV*

6. The kingdom of God is **power**.

*But you shall receive **power** when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 NKJV*

7. The kingdom of God is in the **Holy Spirit**.

*But you shall receive power when the **Holy Spirit** has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 NKJV*

8. Gospel of the **kingdom of God to be preached** as a testimony. The kingdom of God is **near** or **at hand**. Jesus says this 6 times in the Gospels the kingdom is **near** or **at hand**.

*In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, ² and saying, “**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!**”* Matthew 3:1-2

John the Baptist came to prepare the way for the King. The King’s ministry was about to begin.

*For I say to you, among those born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist; but **he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.**”*
Luke 7:28

This shows the significance of those who are inheriting the kingdom of God.

Jesus came preaching the same message as John.

*From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**”* Matthew 4:17

Jesus told His disciples to go, preach and proclaim the kingdom of God is at hand.

*And as you go, preach, saying, ‘**The kingdom of heaven is at hand.**’ ⁸ Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.* Matthew 10:7-8

Jesus said to believe the good news of the kingdom. Jesus said speak shalom to the house.

*⁵ But whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’ And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. And **heal the sick there, and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’** ¹⁰ But whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you, go out into its streets and say, ¹¹ ‘The very dust of your city which clings to us we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the **kingdom of God has come near you.**’* Luke 10:5-11

This is the scripture used in the **house church movement** around the world. The man who receives peace in his house receives the King and all those in his house. This is growing fast in China, India, Bangladesh as they proclaim this scripture.

*And this **gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world** as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.* Matthew 24:14

Luke 21 is talking about the last generation

*So you also, when you see these things happening, know that the **kingdom** of God is **near**.* Luke 21:31

Jesus taught His disciples for forty days about the kingdom before He returned to heaven. This was in answer to the question the disciples asked, “When will the kingdom be restored to Israel?”

*...Jesus began both to do and teach, ²until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen, ³to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them **during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.** Acts 1:1-3*

*And heal the sick there, and say to them, ‘The **kingdom** of God has come **near** to you.’* Luke 10:9

Luke 21 gives signs of the end. Jerusalem will be unified as the capital of Israel. These are signs that the kingdom of God is near. Jesus will return as King. All these things will be fulfilled.

God told us to invest in the next generation. God is multi-generational

8. The kingdom of God is not observed it **is with you**.

The King of healing is the Great Physician who is in your heart. The King and the kingdom lives in you!

9. The kingdom of God is where the mind of God is manifest. The wisdom of God, the mind of the King.

10. the kingdom of God is where the **glory of the King shines** on the face of the King and His people.

*But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the **glory** of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image **from glory to glory**, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.* 2 Corinthians 3:18

*Arise, shine; For your light has come! And **the glory of the LORD is risen upon you**. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the LORD will arise over you, And **His glory will be seen upon you**. The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising.* Isaiah 60:1-3

Thank God that the glory is on the face of the King.

*For Yours is the **kingdom** and the **power** and the **glory** forever.* Matthew 6:13

The King's prayer.

11. The kingdom of God is in **heaven** and is being restored to earth as it is in heaven.
Kingdom come in the Holy Spirit, in you.
The kingdom will come in fullness when the King comes back on the throne of David
The kingdom of God is being restored on the earth.

12. The kingdom of God is our **inheritance** our **destiny** as believers.
We must preach the kingdom of God more.
There are 18 scriptures on who **will** inherit the kingdom of God
There are 12 scriptures on who **will not** inherit the kingdom of God

Colossian 12:2-3 inheritance in the kingdom
The kingdom which can not be shaken
Blessed are the poor in spirit who will inherit the kingdom.
It is impossible for a rich man to enter the kingdom. *All things are possible with God*

Matthew 25 come into the blessed inheritance of the prepared kingdom of God
Our inheritance is the kingdom of God. Contend for kingdom of God as our destiny.
Come with you manifest in the restore kingdom of God in Israel prepare the way for the coming King.

Luke 22 confirming the kingdom of God
Bestow a kingdom. The king confirms His kingdom
I am a child of God
We are clothed in the righteousness of the King
Contend for the kingdom of God as with unshakeable kingdom

Kingdom of God comes and is manifested to children. Be like children with faith who look to our Father. *"seek first the kingdom of God.*
The Father is giving you the kingdom. Our treasure is in heaven which never fails.
Understand what the kingdom of God is
Study, and seek to inherit the kingdom. Restore the message of the kingdom of God

When will the Kingdom of God fully come to earth?

The Lord Jesus will return to earth to rule and reign over all the nations of the world.

Sadly, this will be a hostile take over of those rulers of the nations who oppose Him.
*"Why are the nations so angry? Why do they waste their time with futile plans? 2
The kings of the earth prepare for battle; the rulers plot together against the
LORD and against his anointed one. (Jesus) 3 "Let us break their chains," they
cry, "and free ourselves from slavery to God." Psalm 2:1-3 NLT*

The idea of these world rulers opposing the plans of God is foolish and laughable.
"But the one who rules in heaven laughs. The Lord scoffs at them." Psalm 2:4 NLT

The Good News of the Kingdom

It is God's plan to place His Son Jesus on the throne of David in Jerusalem, and give all the nations of the world to Him as His inheritance.

For the Lord declares, "I have placed my chosen king on the throne in Jerusalem, on my holy mountain." The king proclaims the LORD's decree: "The LORD said to me, 'You are my son. Today I have become your Father. Only ask, and I will give you the nations as your inheritance, the whole earth as your possession.'" Psalm 2:6-8 NLT

There is great joy for those who take refuge in Jesus.

*"Now then, you kings, act wisely! Be warned, you rulers of the earth! ¹¹ Serve the LORD with reverent fear, and rejoice with trembling. ¹² Submit to God's royal son, or he will become angry, and you will be destroyed in the midst of all your activities—for his anger flares up in an instant. But **what joy for all who take refuge in Him!**" Psalm 2:10-12 NLT*

The coming day of the Lord is called a great and terrible day. Joel 2:11

- This will be a *great* day for the obedient saints who have prepared their hearts to meet the Lord.
- This will be a *terrible* day for those who do not repent and continue to sin and rebel against God.

The end of *this* age will come after the 7 years of tribulation, and the 21 judgments of God, and the wrath of God has been pour out on the Devil, the Antichrist, the false prophet and their world system of evil religion and government. All those who rebel and are evil will all be locked away.

After the tribulation will come the glorious Millennial Age, the 1000 year rule and reign of Jesus with His saints on the earth bringing the fulfilled Kingdom of God. Praise God!

*"Blessed and holy are those who share in the first resurrection. For them the second death holds no power, but **they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him a thousand years.**" Revelation 20:6 NLT*

What will happen at the end of the 1000 year reign of Jesus on the earth?

Jesus will prepare the earth to welcome God to His Holy habitation on earth. Then truly heaven will come and be joined to earth.

*"I heard a loud shout from the throne, ..., "Look, **God's home is now among his people! He will live with them, and they will be his people. God himself will be with them.**" Revelation 21:3 NLT*

Now this all gives us great hope!

We have great hope in our future in Christ and as citizens of the Kingdom of God forever!

*“And this is the secret: **Christ lives in you.** This gives you assurance of sharing His glory.”* Colossians 1:27b NLT
