

Confession Repentance and Cleansing of Sin

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleans us from all unrighteousness.” (1 John 1:9)

The Apostle Paul calls you to live in the Spirit and apart from sin: *“Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires.” (Galatians 5:24)* This is so God can grow the fruits of the Spirit in sin's place.

You have to spend time with God removing the sin that robs your joy, steals your blessings, and ruins your relationships. First identify the sin and then be encouraged to confess, repent, and turn away from them through the power of the Holy Spirit.
