

## **'Praise the Lord' in Psalms**

Psalm 100:4 Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, *And* into His courts with **praise**. Be thankful to Him, *and* bless His name.

Psalm 7:1 O **LORD** my God, in You I put my trust; Save me from all those who persecute me; And deliver me,

Psalm 7:17 I will **praise the LORD** according to His righteousness, And will sing **praise to the name of the LORD** Most High.

Psalm 9:1 I will **praise You, O LORD**, with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works.

Psalm 9:11 Sing **praises to the LORD**, who dwells in Zion! Declare His deeds among **the people**.

Psalm 18:3 I will call upon the **LORD, who is worthy to be praised**; So shall I be saved from my enemies.

Psalm 18:49 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O **LORD**, among the Gentiles, And sing **praises to Your name**.

Psalm 22:23 You who fear the **LORD, praise Him!** All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!

Psalm 22:26 The poor shall eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will **praise the LORD**. Let your heart live forever!

Psalm 24 The earth *is* the **LORD's**, and all its fullness, The world and those who dwell therein. **2** For He has founded it upon the seas, And established it upon the waters. **3** Who may ascend into the hill of the **LORD**? Or who may stand in His holy place? **4** He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully. **5** He shall receive blessing from the **LORD**, And righteousness from the God of his salvation. **6** This *is* Jacob, the generation of those who seek Him, Who seek Your face. *Selah* **7** Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. **8** Who *is* this King of glory? The **LORD** strong and mighty, The **LORD** mighty in battle. **9** Lift up your heads, O you gates! Lift up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. **10** Who is this King of glory? The **LORD** of hosts, He *is* the King of glory. *Selah*

Psalm 27:6 And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing **praises to the LORD**.

Psalm 28:7 **The LORD** *is* my strength and my shield; My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; Therefore my heart greatly rejoices, And with my song **I will praise Him**.

Psalm 29:1 **Praise** to God in His Holiness and Majesty Give unto **the LORD**, O you mighty ones, **Give unto the LORD glory and strength**.

Psalm 30:4 Sing **praise** to **the LORD**, you saints of His, And give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.

Psalm 30:12 To the end that *my* glory may sing **praise** to You and not be silent. O **LORD** my God, I will give thanks to You forever.

Psalm 33:1 **Rejoice in the LORD**, O you righteous! *For praise* from the upright is beautiful.

Psalm 33:2 **Praise the LORD** with **the** harp; Make melody to Him with an instrument of ten strings.

Psalm 34:1 **I will bless the LORD** at all times; **His praise** *shall* continually *be* in my mouth.

Psalm 40:3 He has put a new song in my mouth— **Praise** to our God; Many will see *it* and fear, And will **trust in the LORD**.

Psalm 48:1 **Great is the LORD**, and greatly to be **praised** In the city of our God, *In* His holy mountain.

Psalm 56:10 In God (I will **praise** *His* word), In **the LORD** (I will **praise** *His* word),

Psalm 57:9 I will **praise** You, O **Lord**, among **the** peoples; I will sing to You among the nations.

Psalm 68:32 Sing to God, you kingdoms of the earth; Oh, sing **praises** to **the Lord**, *Selah*

Psalm 78:4 We will not hide *them* from their children, Telling to the generation to come the **praises** of **the LORD**, And His strength and His wonderful works that He has done.

Psalm 89:5 And the heavens will **praise** Your wonders, O **LORD**; Your faithfulness also in **the** assembly of **the** saints.

Psalm 92:1 **Praise to the LORD** for His Love and Faithfulness *It is* good to give thanks to **the LORD**, And to sing **praises to Your name**, O Most High;

Psalm 96:1 Oh, sing to **the LORD** a new song! Sing to **the LORD**, all **the** earth.

Psalm 96:4 For **the LORD** *is* great and greatly to be **praised**; He *is* to be feared above all gods.

Psalm 97:1 **The LORD** reigns; Let **the** earth rejoice; Let **the** multitude of isles be glad!

Psalm 98:1 Oh, sing to **the LORD** a new song! For He has done marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him **the** victory.

Psalm 98:4 Shout joyfully to **the LORD**, all **the** earth; Break forth in song, rejoice, and sing **praises**.

Psalm 99:1 **The LORD** reigns; Let the peoples tremble! He dwells *between* **the** cherubim;  
Let **the** earth be moved!

Psalm 100:1 Make a joyful shout to **the LORD**, all you lands!

Psalm 101:1 I will sing of mercy and justice; To You, O **LORD**, **I will sing praises**.

Psalm 102:18 This will be written for the generation to come, That a people yet to be created  
may **praise the LORD**.

Psalm 102:21 To declare the name of **the LORD** in Zion, And His **praise** in Jerusalem,

Psalm 103:1 **Bless the LORD**, O my soul; And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name!

Psalm 104:1 **Bless the LORD**, O my soul! O **LORD** my God, You are very great: You are clothed  
with honor and majesty,

Psalm 104:33 I will sing to the **LORD** as long as I live; I will sing **praise** to my God while I have  
my being.

Psalm 104:35 May sinners be consumed from **the** earth, And **the** wicked be no more.  
**Bless the LORD**, O my soul! **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 105:45 That **they** might observe His statutes And keep His laws. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 106:1 **Praise the LORD!** Oh, give thanks to **the LORD**, for *He is* good! For His  
mercy *endures* forever.

Psalm 106:2 Who can utter the mighty acts of **the LORD**? Who can declare all His **praise**?

Psalm 106:47 Save us, O **LORD** our God, And gather us from among the Gentiles, To give thanks  
to Your holy name, To triumph in **Your praise**.

Psalm 106:48 Blessed *be* **the LORD** God of Israel From everlasting to everlasting! And let  
all **the** people say, "Amen!" **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 108:3 I will **praise** You, O **LORD**, among **the** peoples, And I will sing **praises** to You  
among **the** nations.

Psalm 109:30 I will greatly **praise the LORD** with my mouth; Yes, I will **praise** Him  
among **the** multitude.

Psalm 111:1 **Praise the LORD!** I will **praise the LORD** with *my* whole heart, In **the** assembly  
of **the** upright and *in* **the** congregation.

Psalm 111:10 **The** fear of **the LORD** *is* **the** beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do *His commandments*. His **praise** endures forever.

Psalm 112:1 **Praise the LORD!** Blessed *is* **the** man *who* fears **the LORD**, *Who* delights greatly in His commandments.

Psalm 113:1 **Praise the LORD! Praise,** O servants of **the LORD**, **Praise the** name of **the LORD!**

Psalm 113:3 From the rising of **the** sun to its going down **The LORD's** name *is* to be **praised**.

Psalm 113:9 He grants the barren woman a home, Like a joyful mother of children. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 115:17 The dead do not **praise the LORD**, Nor any who go down into silence.

Psalm 115:18 But we will bless **the LORD** From this time forth and forevermore. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 116:19 In the courts of **the LORD's** house, In **the** midst of you, O Jerusalem. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 117:1 **Praise the LORD**, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!

Psalm 117:2 For His merciful kindness is great toward us, And **the** truth of **the LORD** *endures* forever. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 118:1 Oh, give thanks to **the LORD**, for *He is* good! For His mercy *endures* forever.

Psalm 118:19 Open to me **the** gates of righteousness; I will go through **them**, *And* I will **praise the LORD**.

Psalm 135:1 **Praise the LORD! Praise the** name of **the LORD**; **Praise Him**, O you servants of **the LORD!**

Psalm 135:3 **Praise the LORD**, for **the LORD** *is* good; Sing **praises** to His name, for *it is* pleasant.

Psalm 135:21 Blessed be **the LORD** out of Zion, Who dwells in Jerusalem! **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 138:1 I will **praise** You with my whole heart; Before **the** gods I will sing **praises** to You.

Psalm 138:4 All the kings of the earth shall **praise** You, O **LORD**, When **they** hear **the** words of Your mouth.

Psalm 145:3 Great *is* **the LORD**, and greatly to be **praised**; And His greatness *is* unsearchable.

## ***'Praise the Lord' in Psalms***

Psalm 145:21 My mouth shall speak **the praise** of **the LORD**, And all flesh shall bless His holy name Forever and ever.

Psalm 146:1 **Praise the LORD! Praise the LORD**, O my soul!

Psalm 146:2 While I live I will **praise the LORD**; I will sing **praises** to my God while I have my being.

Psalm 146:10 **The LORD** shall reign forever— Your God, O Zion, to all generations. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 147:1 **Praise the LORD!** For *it is* good to sing **praises** to our God; For *it is* pleasant, *and praise* is beautiful.

Psalm 147:7 Sing to **the LORD** with thanksgiving; Sing **praises** on **the** harp to our God,

Psalm 147:12 **Praise the LORD**, O Jerusalem! **Praise** your God, O Zion!

Psalm 147:20 He has not dealt thus with any nation; And *as for His* judgments, **they** have not known **them**. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 148:1 **Praise the LORD! Praise the LORD** from **the** heavens; **Praise** Him in **the** heights

Psalm 148:5 Let **them praise the** name of **the LORD**, For He commanded and **they** were created.

Psalm 148:7 **Praise the LORD** from **the** earth, You great sea creatures and all **the** depths;

Psalm 148:13 Let them **praise the** name of **the LORD**, For His name alone is exalted; His glory *is* above **the** earth and heaven.

Psalm 148:14 And He has exalted the horn of His people, **The praise** of all His saints— Of **the** children of Israel, A people near to Him. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 149:1 **Praise the LORD!** Sing to **the LORD** a new song, *And* His **praise** in **the** assembly of saints.

Psalm 149:9 To execute on **them the** written judgment— This honor have all His saints. **Praise the LORD!**

Psalm 150 Praise the LORD! Praise God in His sanctuary;  
Praise Him in His mighty firmament!**2** Praise Him for His mighty acts; Praise Him according to His excellent greatness!**3** Praise Him with the sound of the trumpet; Praise Him with the lute and harp!**4** Praise Him with the timbrel and dance; Praise Him with stringed instruments and flutes!  
**5** Praise Him with loud cymbals; Praise Him with clashing cymbals!**6** Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD!
